

You CAN reduce your Utility Bill

Refrigerators

Fluorescent light bulbs

Compact Fluorescent lamps use 75% less energy than a standard light bulb and last up to 10 times longer.

Air leaks

Air leaks can cause warm and cool air to escape. Check your doors and windows for leaks. Add weather stripping and repair any holes or gaps. Wall insulation and insulated windows will save you money and make you more comfortable in both the winter and the summer.
